

MT CARMEL 2023 SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS

In Term 1, a Statement for financial contributions for the whole year is issued for every child made up of Mt Carmel School Contributions and Catholic Diocese of Auckland Attendance Dues and Contributions (which are collected by Mt Carmel School and paid over to the Catholic Diocese every term).

Mt Carmel School Contributions*:

Activity / Stationery / RE Contribution*:	\$ 270.00
<i>This contributes towards the cost of providing stationery, external trips, visitors to the school, RE Professional development, and resources etc. (Tax deductible)</i>	
Swimming Lessons	\$ 164.00
<i>Every child is encouraged to take part in swimming lessons – If you agree to your child taking part in swimming lessons this is the charge to be paid and paid BEFORE swimming lessons take place in Term 4.</i>

We are obliged to pay the Attendance Dues to the Diocese promptly and so we ask that you help us by paying by the dates requested.
